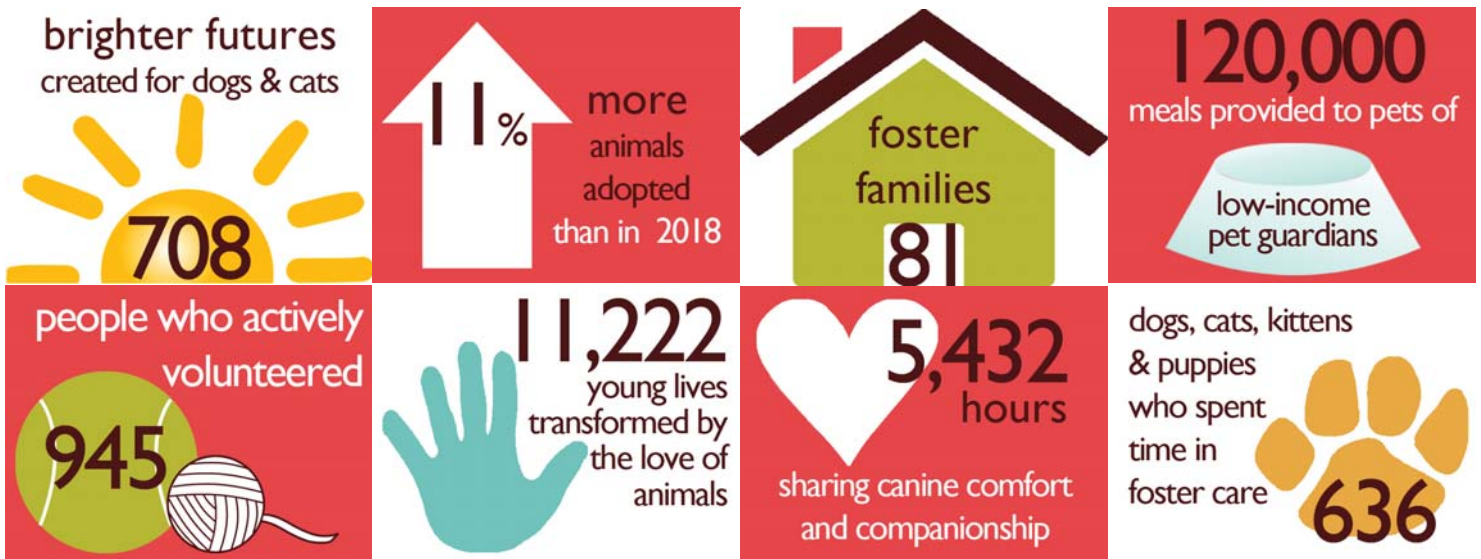




DONOR IMPACT

Thanks to you, our community programs and services grew and flourished: Canine Comfort pet therapy received awards from two local school districts, while the AniMeals pet food pantry served more households than ever before.
