

Thanks to you, our team continued its essential work without pause, quickly pivoting to adapt operations and develop a safe adoption protocol in order to meet sharply growing needs in the community, including a 400% rise in people needing assistance feeding their pets. At a time when the role of pets in our life came into sharp focus – for their companionable, stress-relieving, grief-soothing, unconditional love – you helped us keep people and pets together and facilitate hundreds of happy endings for pets in need of a home. In the end, adoptions increased more than 29%, while the average length of time animals stayed in our care dropped by 37% – significant numbers fueled by new foster families willing to care for dogs and cats awaiting adoption, as well as the formation of our own surgical team able to keep pace with the continuous spay/neuter schedule required by incoming rescues. We are eager to see what we can achieve together in the new year, from the long-awaited opening of our community pet hospital, to translating lessons learned during this pandemic into even greater positive outcomes for pets and people.
