**Prices Include:** Nail trimming, plastic cone collar (to prevent licking incision), and post-operative pain medication. (Dogs receive take-home medication; cats receive a topical medication which relieves pain for 4 days.)

*Please note:* As part of Valley Humane's spay/neuter service, all animals will receive a tattoo to indicate they have been altered (a small green line near the incision). **If you do not want your animal tattooed, please seek spay/neuter services at your regular veterinary clinic.** 

Additional fees apply for animals that are in heat, pregnant, overweight, brachycephalic (flat face breeds), or weigh more than 75 lbs. For dogs, additional sedatives to take home are priced based on the weight of your pet. Please inquire on the day of surgery.
